LOCATION

Grahams Island State Park

ELIGIBILITY

Teams will consist of: 1 Adult and up to 3 Children, or 2 Adults and 2 Children in one of the divisions, of which one adult must be a LRAA member

DIVISIONS

This is a two (2) division outing:

- 1) Adult Bantam (Child age 2 10)
- 2) Adult Junior (Child age 11 17)

Qualifying divisions will be based on the youthful angler's age on the date of the Adult-Child Outing.

REGULATIONS

All contestants must observe U.S. Coast Guard and ND Game and Fish Dept. rules, regulations, laws and license requirements. **Life preservers must be worn when boat is on plane.** Shore fishing will be allowed. Team members must fish within 100 feet of each other at all times. Boats and vehicles may be boarded and checked at random. All fish must be contained to a live well or cooler. No stringers or baskets allowed All teams are responsible for their fish following the tournament. Contestants are reminded that the "Spirit of the Rule" will prevail in all judgment cases.

• FISHING AREA

All navigable waters of Devils Lake or directly connected.

FISHING HOURS

Outing will run from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

• CHECK - OUT AND CHECK - IN

Teams are requested to register at least $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before the designated start time. Each team will have their boat checked and receive a numbered team key tag. In order to check-in one team member must deliver their key tag to the scoreboard before the 3:00 p.m. finish time or they will be considered late. Teams may then proceed to weigh-in their catch.

ENTRY FEE

Entry fee shall be \$5.00 per person. Checks should be made payable to the Lake Region Anglers Association.

A light meal will be served following the outing.

In the event of cancellation or rescheduling due to inclement weather the outing will be held Sunday July 18 or if cancelled entry fees will be refunded. Tournament field is limited to 49 teams.

SCORING

Each team can weigh in: 5 Walleye, 3 Northern Pike, and 10 White Bass, Crappies or Perch. The minimum length requirements for Walleyes are 15 inches and for Northern Pike 20 inches.

Teams who return within 15 minutes after check in time will be penalized ten (10) percent of their total weight and be disqualified for largest fish prize. Over 15 minutes late will result in a disqualification. All fish will be weighed in on the LRAA official scale.

PRIZES

Plaques will be awarded to the top five (5) teams in each division and to the anglers catching the largest Walleye, Northern Pike and White Bass. Each child will receive a participation award.

WEATHER
