• **LOCATION**

Grahams Island State Park

• **ELIGIBILITY**

Two (2) or four (4) person teams; of which one adult must be a LRAA member. The two (2) person team will consist of one (1) male and one (1) female. The four (4) person team will consist of two (2) males and two (2) females.

• **REGULATIONS**

All contestants must observe U.S. Coast Guard and ND Game and Fish Dept. rules, regulations, laws and license requirements. **Life preservers must be worn when boat is on plane.** Boats must land at tournament headquarters only. Boats may be boarded and checked at random. All fish must be contained to a live well or cooler. No stringers or baskets allowed **All teams are responsible for their fish following the tournament.** Contestants are reminded that the "Spirit of the Rule" will prevail in all judgment cases.

• **FISHING AREA**

All navigable waters of Devils Lake or directly connected.

• **FISHING HOURS**

Outing will run from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

• **CHECK - OUT AND CHECK - IN**

Teams are requested to register and check-in at least ½ hour before starting time. Each team will have their boat checked and receive a numbered key tag. In order to check-in, one team member must deliver their key tag to the scoreboard before the 3:00 p.m. finish time or they will be considered late. Teams may then proceed to weigh-in their catch.

• **ENTRY FEE**

Entry fee shall be \$25.00 per two-person team. Checks should be made payable to the Lake Region Anglers Association. **In the event of inclement weather, the outing will be Sunday August 15** or if cancelled entry fees will be refunded. Tournament is limited to 49 teams.

• **SCORING**

Each team can weigh in: 5 Walleye, 3 Northern Pike and 10 White Bass, Perch or Crappie. The minimum length requirements for Walleyes are 15 inches and for Northern Pike 20 inches.

Teams who return within 15 minutes after check in time will be penalized ten (10) percent of their total weight and will be disqualified for largest fish prize. Over 15 minutes late will result in a disqualification. All fish will be weighed in on the LRAA official scale.

• **PRIZES**

Prize will be two (2) plaques, one for each member of each of the top five (5) teams. *Plaques for the largest Walleye, Northern Pike and White Bass will be given. Each female participant will receive a Walleye Widows award.

• **WEATHER**

Listen to the local radio stations for cancellation and rescheduling information.
