LOCATION

Lakewood Boat Ramp

FISHING AREA

Outing boundaries will be all navigable waters of Devils Lake or directly connected to, boats will leave ramp with a controlled start. All boats will leave single file starting with boat #1.

FISHING HOURS

The outing fishing hours will run from 8AM to 3PM.

ELIGIBILITY

An eligible fishing teams shall be made up of 1 female and 1 male , or 2 females and 2 males, 1 person must be 18 years or older and a member of LRAA.

REGULATIONS

All contestants must observe US Coast Guard and ND Game & Fish Dept. rules, regulations, laws and license requirements. Life preservers must be worn when boat is on plane. All teams are responsible for their fish following the outing. Contestants are reminded that the "Spirit of the Rule" will prevail in all judgment cases.

REGISTRATION—CHECK –IN—WEIGH-IN

Teams must register prior to the outing scheduled time. No late entries will be allowed. Each team will undergo a boat check and be issued a team number. At the weighin one member of the team must deliver their number to the scoreboard, even if the team does not have any fish toto to weigh. The team may then load their boat and proceed to weigh-in their catch.

AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES INSPECTION

All boats must be inspected for ANS prior to doing any fishing or entry into a LRAA outing. Anglers will be required to sign-off on a ANS questionnaire form during registration prior to fishing in LRAA outing.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fee shall be \$25.00 per two person team. Checks should be made payable to LRAA. In the event of cancellation due to inclement weather the Outing will be held the following Sunday. If the Outing is cancelled all entry fees will be refunded. The Outing is limited to 49 teams. Listen to local radio stations for cancellation and rescheduling information.

SCORING

Team standings shall be determined by a total weight of 5 Northern Pike, 5 Walleye and 5 White Bass or Perch. Northern Pike must be a minimum of 20 inches and the Walleye must a minimum of 15 inches. There will be no early weigh-in unless arrangements have been made with Outing directors.

PRIZES

Prizes will be 2 plaques, one for each female member of the top 5 teams. One plaque for the largest Northern Pike, Walleye and White Bass, also each female will receive a special keepsake. Cash prizes will be awarded to the top five teams based on 75% of the entry fees received. Pay-out as follows-1st 33%, 2nd 27%, 3rd 20%, 4th 13% and 5th 7%.
