RULES

- 1. Three people per team, 2 must be age 17 or younger; and one adult, age 18 or older. Proof of age may be required.
- 2. FM Walleyes Unlimited, Inc; Lake Region Anglers Association; Angler Young Angler; Devils Lake Park Board; and sponsors are not to be held responsible for death, injury, damage, liability, theft, fire or any loss. Entrants will in effect sign a waiver upon signing the entry form.
- 3. All Sport Fishing and Coast Guard Regulations apply, anyone caught breaking these regulations may be disqualified.
- 4. Attendance at the Rules meeting is mandatory. Rules meeting will be held on July 9 at 6 PM at a location to be announced.
- 5. Fishing hours will be from 8:30 AM 3:30 PM commencing by a trickle start. Any team returning late may be disqualified.
- 6. If tournament director cancels fishing on July 10, 2010 for any reason, the tournament make up date is July 11, 2010.
- 7. Tether kill switch strap must be worn at all times of travel above idle speed.
- 8. Boat, live well and kill switch operation inspection will take place from 7:45 AM 8:15 AM at the Lakewood Access ramp. Every team must have an operating live well and kill switch.
- 9. A maximum of 5 fish (walleye or sauger) per team will be weighed. You may have 8 fish maximum in the live well at any time. Culling is not allowed.
- 10. Fish may be weighed at any time during tournament hours.
- 11. The competitors are responsible for the handling, processing, and disposition of their team's fish after official weigh in.
- 12. No alcoholic beverages allowed at any time during tournament events.
- 13. Tournament boundaries are all navigable waters in the Devils Lake basin.
- 14. Prizes will be awarded in order of the team's heaviest weight. In the case of a tie, the team's heaviest fish will determine the winner, or via a coin toss.
- 15. Everyone must wear a lifejacket at all times.
- 16. Every team must be present for a group photo at the end of the tournament.
- 17. Every team must launch from the Lakewood Access ramp.
- 18. In order to be eligible for prizes each team must return and report to the main dock by no later than 3:30 PM.
- 19. Decisions made by the tournament director(s) will be final.
- 20. All entries not necessarily accepted and a 20% overbook may be accepted.
- 21. Disqualification will result in forfeiture of entry fee.
- 22. All protests must be presented in writing to a tournament director to be valid and ruled upon.
- 23. It is the intention of the tournament organizers to provide an honest, sportsmanlike children's fishing tournament. In the interest of good sportsmanship, contestants are reminded that the spirit of the rule will prevail in all judgment cases.
